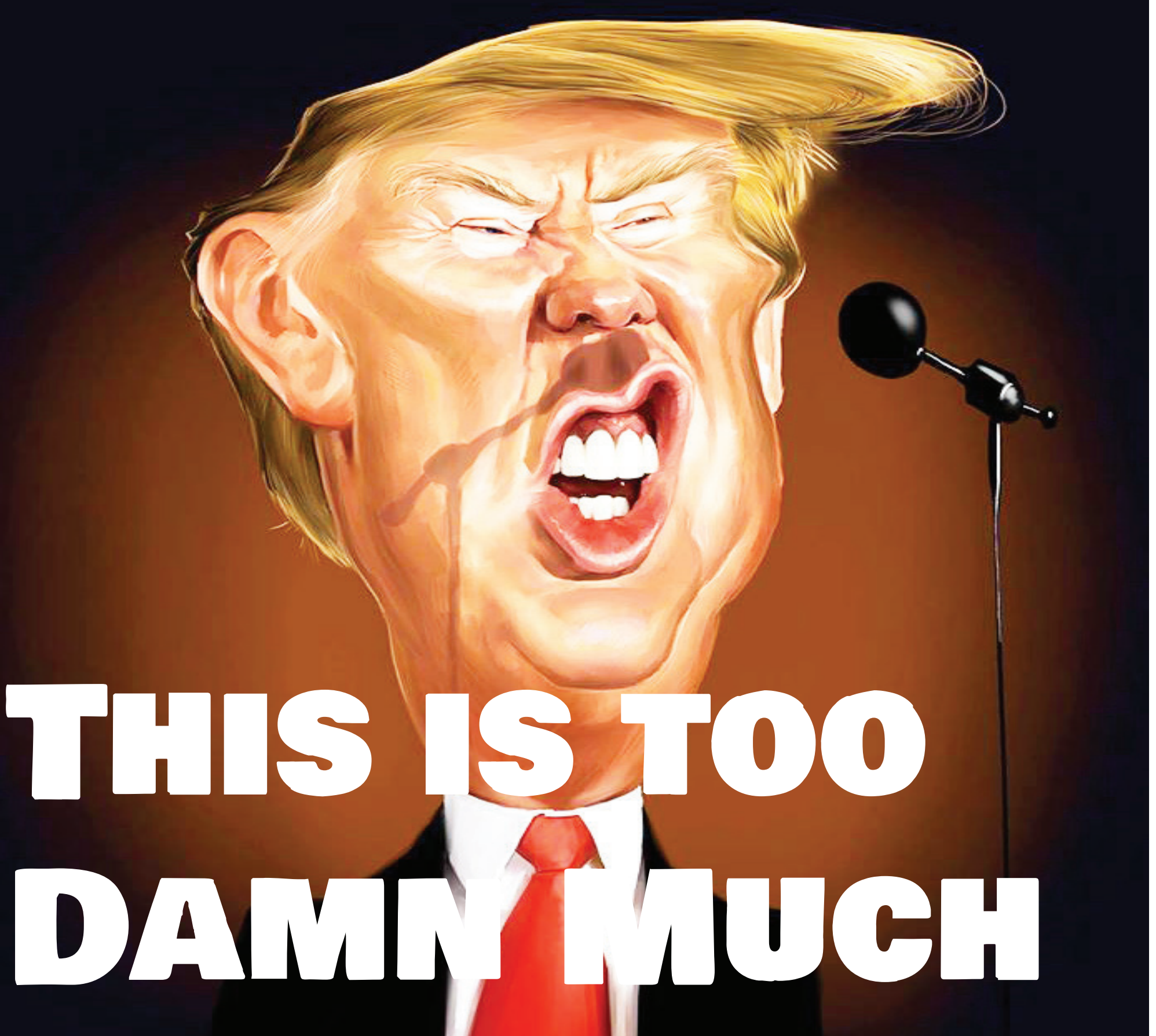

COMPENSATORY-FUNCTIONAL DEFINITIONS

Compiled from "The United Independent Compensatory Code/System/Concept by Mr. Neely Fuller Jr.

Racist suspect, and/or suspected racist

1. Any person classified as "white", and/or "Caucasian", who exists any place in the known universe, at the same time that any person classified as "non-white" exist, and functions, in direct or indirect subjugation to persons who practice white supremacy (racism).
2. Any person classified as "white", and/or "Caucasian", who exists, and/or who had existed, during a time when white supremacy (racism) is, and/or was, practiced among the people of the known universe.
3. Any person classified as "white", and/or "Caucasian", who, during any social material condition dominated by white supremacists (racists), has not proven, by both word, and deed, to the victims of white supremacy (non-white people), that he, or she, is not a white supremacists.
4. Any person classified as, and/or generally functioning as, "white", and/or "Caucasian", who is suspected of practicing racism (white supremacy), by any person who is non-white.
5. Any white person who receives social and/or material benefits as a direct or indirect result of white supremacy (racism), but, who does not utilize all of these social and/or material benefits to help to eliminate white supremacy.
6. Any person classified as "white" and/or "Caucasian", who, during any social material condition dominated by white supremacy (racism), attempts to engage in any form of sexual intercourse, and/or sexual play, with any non-white person.

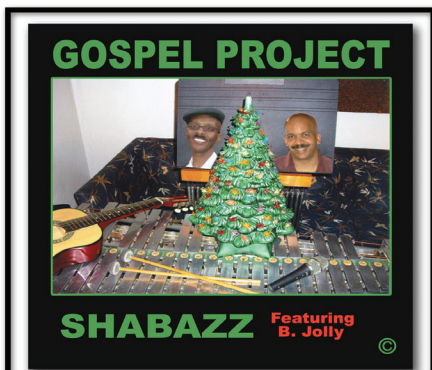

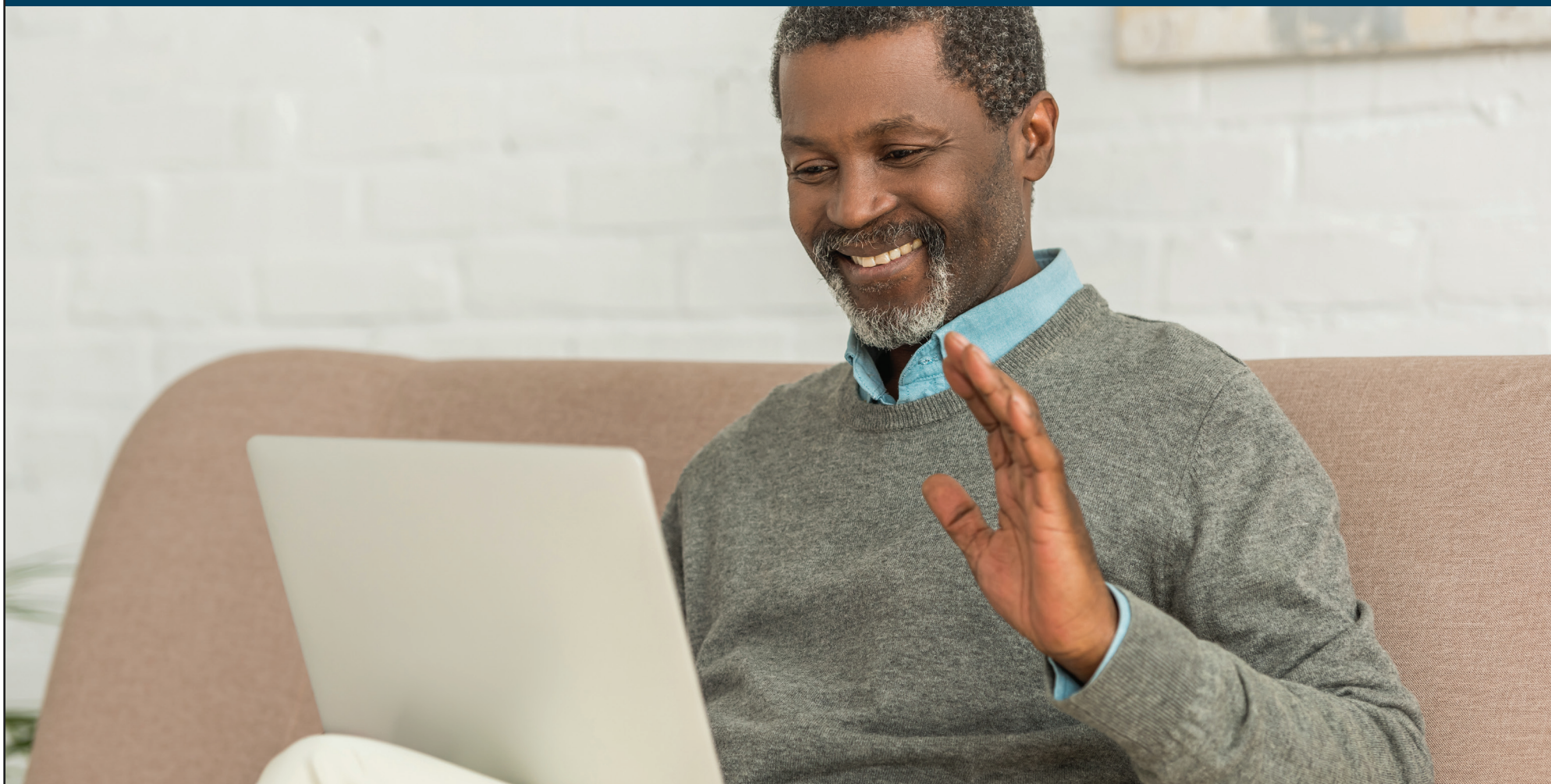

They Saw It Coming But Did Nothing

- Part Two

In the April 6 issue of The Nubian News "They Saw It Coming But Did Nothing," it stated the US Department of Health and Human Services from January 2019 to August conducted a scenario named "Crimson Contagion" to see how the federal government would respond to a fictional pandemic. The scenario included participation from 19 federal agencies, a dozen states, hospitals and nongovernmental organizations.

Numerous times during the recent coronavirus the con artist-in-chief has repeated the lie that no one could have imagined such a pandemic occurring. That such a situation was beyond anyone's imagination. "Who would have thought?... Who would have ever imagined this could have ever happened?" But we know this is just another of the many lies the degenerate-in-chief has told the public.

Perhaps, the scoundrel-in-chief's imagination like his leadership abilities is severely challenged. However, others in his administration were able to imagine a pandemic like the one we are currently experiencing. Under the "Crimson Contagion" scenario conducted last year, the US would experience a severe influenza pandemic for which there was no vaccine. The fictional outbreak involved a group of tourists visiting China who then become infected and fly home to various countries, including the US.

In the scenario, the virus is first detected in the US in Chicago. From there it spreads rapidly throughout the US primarily impacting metropolitan areas and large cities.

The scenario showed the current regime was unprepared and ill equipped on many levels to handle a pandemic and the current coronavirus pandemic has borne that out.

In November 2019, US intelligence became aware of the coronavirus outbreak in China and expressed concern. Health experts monitoring the outbreak saw that the virus seemed to be most lethal to seniors and those with pre-existing health issues such as diabetes and high blood pressure.

Which forces us to have to use our imagination. What if a few individuals who participated in the scenario or were aware of the scenario while standing around a water cooler in the West Wing of the White House or over drinks in a DC wateringhole

after initially bemoaning the results of the scenario decided that a pandemic might not be bad in fact actually prove useful? That is if the pandemic was virtually limited to the major urban areas of the US with their large Black populations how bad would that actually be they wondered? "They are not our people, not our voters."

"Sir, thank you for taking our meeting and agreeing to meet in private," said the leader of the group who had requested to meet with the imposter-in-chief about the coronavirus.

As a result of the many racist, inhumane actions and policies of the current regime is such a scheme beyond the imaginable? Or to put it another way, is it possible that what we have taken for being gross incompetence in dealing with the coronavirus response by the current regime may in fact be intentional neglect?

Gross incompetence or intentional neglect whichever one Blacks have been disproportionately affected by the coronavirus. People with underlying conditions are more affected by the coronavirus, and in the US, Black people are more likely to have underlying health issues such as diabetes, heart disease, obesity and lung disease. A look at the data highlights the deadly impact the coronavirus has had on Blacks.

As of April 3, Blacks made up almost half of Milwaukee County's 945 cases and 81% of its 27 deaths in a county whose population is 26% Black. In Michigan, where the state's population is 14% Black, Blacks made up 35% of cases and 40% of deaths.

In Chicago 70% of the deaths reported were Black despite Blacks being only 30% of the population. In Louisiana 70% of those who died were Black despite Blacks making up only 32% of the population. What will the final numbers for other metropolitan areas show?

Illinois and North Carolina are two of the few areas publishing statistics on coronavirus cases by race, and their data shows a disproportionate number of Blacks were infected.

As the number of Blacks who become affected and die from the coronavirus continues to rise we are forced to wonder if there were those who suspected how the coronavirus would impact urban Blacks and decided to do nothing? Is it that hard to imagine?

Aún no hay autorización para reabrir peluquerías

TRENTON-La reapertura de las barberías, salones de belleza y gimnasios en nuestra área aun no tienen autorización del gobierno estatal para reabrir. El gobernador Phil Murphy, habló hoy lunes sobre algunos objetivos generales que deben lograrse



antes de que el estado pueda comenzar a reabrir sus negocios, pero no dio una fecha específica para cuándo sucedería esto.

"Estamos de acuerdo en que aún no se abran nuestros negocios" dijo Santo Durán propietario de la peluquería "Duran Barber Shop" en el Sur de Trenton. Durán señaló que esta

pausa en sus labores les ha afectado económicamente como a todos, pero que entiende plenamente la situación. Aconsejó a otros peluqueros que no abran sin autorización para evitar las multas que son fuertes.

"Por seguridad de todos, debemos esperar un poco más. Creo que para el 15 de mayo ya podríamos estar en condiciones de reabrir" dijo Durán señalando que esta consiste sobre los esfuerzos que debe aplicar en cuanto a los hábitos de desinfectar y limpieza en sus lugares de trabajo para evitar contraer el virus.

El gobernador Murphy manifestó que la reapertura de la economía y el regreso de las personas a trabajar se

hará de manera metódica, estratégica y responsable.

A último minuto se conoció que los parques estatales de Nueva Jersey se reabrirán desde este sábado dos de mayo según anunció el gobernador Murphy. En todo caso las reglas de distanciamiento social seguirán en vigor y son obligatorias.

¿Quiénes lideran Latinoamérica en tiempos de pandemia?

El mundo está completamente trastornado y diversos presidentes han hecho el ridículo tomando medidas que son criticadas por la misma Organización Mundial de la Salud. Algunos presidentes latinoamericanos han sido noticia por sus declaraciones polémicas frente al COVID-19.

El presidente mexicano Alfonso Manuel López Obrador, hace apenas unas semanas salió a decir



Similar al caso de México en Brasil el presidente Jair Bolsonaro se ha negado a tomar el virus en serio, de hecho ha declarado que "el virus hay que enfrentarlo como hombres. Todos moriremos algún día", esta posición es realmente peligrosa porque todo un país depende de las medidas adoptadas por el gobierno central. Grandes centros urbanos como Sao Paulo concentran el 35% de infectados de el país, y las auto-

ridades sanitarias del país han revelado no tener la capacidad de realizar pruebas a toda la población de Brasil, sólo pueden realizar 258 pruebas por cada millón de habitantes (el país cuenta con 210 millones de habitantes)

Es evidente que el panorama en Latinoamérica aún no es tan oscuro como el que está atravesando Europa. Sin embargo, vale la pena resaltar que Latinoamérica es una región con recursos económicos limitados, una gran población de empleados informales que trabajan en las calles, habitantes de calle,

públicamente que las personas no debían sucumbir ante el pánico y debían abrazarse todos, siendo esto una contradicción a las medidas recomendadas a nivel global, que son mantener distancia para evitar la propagación del virus. A pesar de la emergencia que ha causado la pandemia, el presidente de México continuó de gira por el país y se negó a practicarse la prueba del coronavirus, incluso sabiendo que ha tenido reuniones con personas que ya dieron positivo. Su respuesta ante el COVID-19 ha sido una de las razones por las que su popularidad pasara del 58.7% al 46%, según la encuesta Mitofsky que mide la aprobación del presidente a nivel nacional.

Por otro lado, en Ecuador el presidente Lenin Moreno ha declarado que el país no cuenta con los insumos de salud y funerarios necesarios para afrontar la crisis, por lo tanto el gobierno ha inhumado más 50 cadáveres en un terreno, lo que para muchos no es una forma digna de sepultura y lo equiparan a una fosa común. Sin embargo, vale la pena resaltar que este presidente ha reducido su propio sueldo y el de altos mandatarios al 50% para disponer mayores recursos a las emergencias sanitarias.

migrantes y refugiados, es decir, una pandemia de la escala del COVID-19 puede causar estragos mayores que los que está causando en el hemisferio norte.

Por estos motivos, es necesario contar con mandatarios que ante todo respeten a la población, y destinen los recursos necesarios hacia el área de la salud. De nada vale tener una economía fuerte si la población sufre y muere de forma indiscriminada. Los presidentes pueden estar causando risa pero sus acciones, o más bien de la falta de ellas, pueden ser fatales ante lo que se avecina.

Los infectados han aumentado considerablemente y se necesitan acciones oportunas para ayudarlos a ellos y también para auxiliar a aquellos que pueden estar en situación de vulnerabilidad por haber perdido su empleo en esta época de confinamiento. Las economías de todo el mundo se verán afectadas y las consecuencias no serán visibles sino hasta dentro de unos meses cuando el Producto Interno Bruto se contraiga hasta un 4.6 %, según el Banco Mundial. Ante esto las declaraciones ridículas de AMLO, Bolsonaro y otros mandatarios ya no dan risa sino temor.



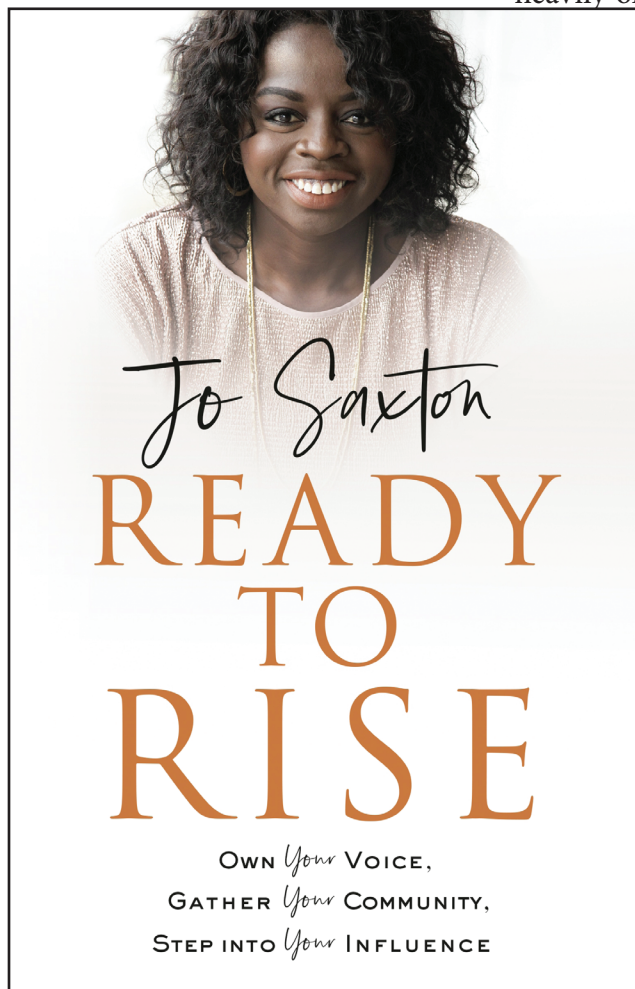
The very first thing you need to know about

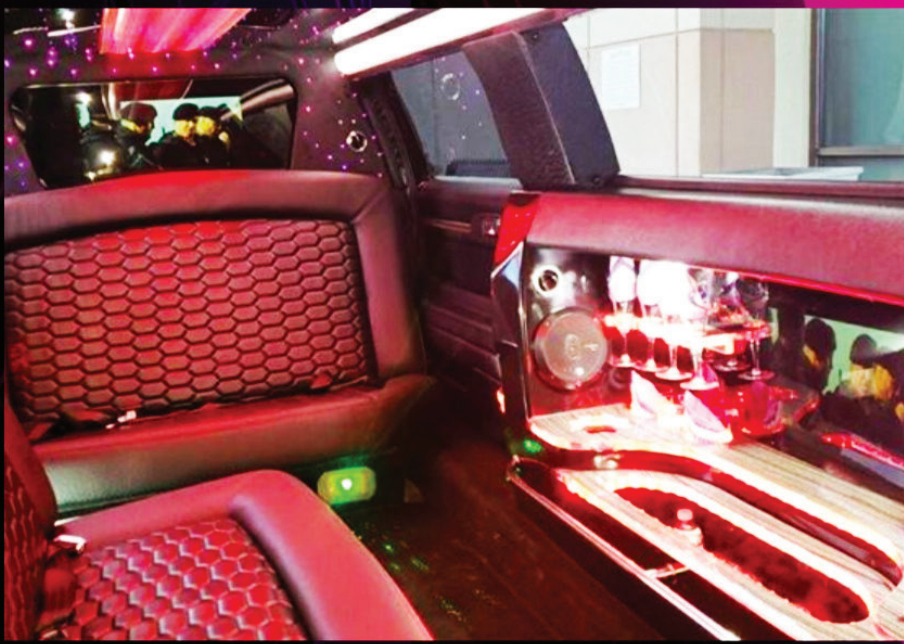


tion. Many were not getting nearly enough money to support their families and needed to get back to work even if the virus was still spreading through the state.

Socioeconomic, language and technological barriers has made COVID-19 a real impact for minority communities

TRENTON-COVID-19 coverage in the trenches of the Latino immigrant community as pluralistic as the Latino community is, so are their stories in the time of COVID-19. The Latino community, as many other immigrant communities with strong ties to their native countries, has been dealing with the implications of COVID-19 both in the US and in their respective countries of origin. Cultural, language, socioeconomic, medical and even technological barriers has made COVID-19 an enemy on various fronts for Latino immigrants.

Take for example Yolanda, she is from Guatemala she recently participated in a conference call organized by Mercer County Council for Young Children a state-sponsored parents support group. On the call she asked basic questions about COVID-19 and expressed that her entire civic association constantly asks basic questions about what it is, if it is real, safety measures, regulations and benefits—this after COVID-19 has been global news for nearly four months. There is also the story of Sara and Barbara, two immigrant mothers with very limited English-language skills who have partnered with local bodegas and agencies to collect and distribute meals and basic-need items to immigrant families who are truly in need. Recall undocumented workers did not receive the stimulus check.

There are also the many stories of Venezuelan refugees whose mass exodus from their home country have

siblings and parents spread across various continents and receive news from loved ones affected in different ways depending on where they live.

There are stories of the impact of COVID-19 on remittances, inability for legal immigrants to travel, corpse transported from the US to a native country, differences in impact of the pandemic based on whether the immigrant entered the US with a visa or crossing the border illegally (without inspection), and of course the massive impact that constant shift in immigration policies from the Trump administration has on aspiring immigrants.

Finally, on that same conference call in which Norma participated in, the state representative answering policy and procedural questions was asked if the state's website or CDC website contained updated information in Spanish—she confirmed the information was only in English. This, highlighting the need for media outlets, big and small, to play a key role.

These stories and many more are perhaps not covered by major media outlets because there is a lack of journalists who are part of the very communities they cover or perhaps it's too expensive to dedicate a journalist to cover these "grassroots" stories. Here there is an opportunity for citizen journalists and ethnic newspapers as The Nubian News & El Latino News to play a key role in news coverage, information and telling our stories.

The Next Genocide

Two days after Easter, perhaps the most sacred of religious observance in Christendom during which believers celebrate life's victory over death as manifest in the resurrection of Christ, the US launched a new campaign of genocide against people of color around the world. On that day, April 14, 2020, the pretender-in-chief of the US announced the US withdrawal of funding in the midst of a pandemic to the World Health Organization. He accused the World Health Organization of mismanaging the spread of the novel coronavirus, and of not acting quickly enough to investigate the virus when it first emerged in China in December 2019.

Each member chooses a delegation of health experts and leaders to represent the country in the World Health Assembly, the organization's decision and policy-making body. The World Health Organization has regional headquarters in Africa, North and South America, Southeast Asia, Europe, the Eastern Mediterranean, and the Western Pacific. There are more than 150 field offices globally, where staff on the ground work with local authorities to provide guidance and health care assistance.

In the 70 years since its founding, the World Health Organization has had its share of successes: it helped eradicate smallpox, reduced polio cases by 99%, and has been on the front lines of the battle against outbreaks like Ebola.

More recently, it is helping countries battle the dengue outbreak in South and Southeast Asia, providing local clinics and health ministries with

training, equipment, financial aid and community resources.

Each member state is required to pay dues to be a part of the organization; and is calculated relative to each country's wealth and population. In the last two year cycle of 2018-2019, the US has given \$893 million the most of any other country. Then again the US supposedly is the richest country with the greatest economy of all time and thus as the Bible says, "To whom much is given, much will be required."

However, the illywhacker-in-chief is halting funding to the World Health Organization in an attempt to fool the American people as to who really is to blame for the US having more cases of coronavirus and more deaths than any other nation in the world.
